# Romania - 160 years of ITU membership

A founding member of the Union since 1866, Romania has been an active and committed contributor to the work of the ITU for 160 years. During this time, Romanian experts have consistently participated in the Union's activities, earning the trust of Member States to serve in leadership positions at Plenipotentiary Conferences, World Conferences, Council and Study Groups across the Radiocommunication, Standardization and Development Sectors.

## A strategic partner

In the working formats of ITU-D, Romania led the chairmanship of Committee 3 of WTDC-22 and it was fully engaged in the preparatory process of the World Telecommunication Development Conference (WTDC-25), which took place on November 2025 in Baku, Azerbaijan. During WTDC-25, Romania's representative was elected vice-chair of the Working Group of the Plenary and re-elected as vice-chair of Study Group 2 for the 2025 – 2029 cycle.

In the field of International Standards, Romania led the European preparations and involvement in the World Telecommunication Standardization Assembly (WTSA-24), which took place from 15 to 24 October 2024, in New Delhi, India, being elected as vice-chair of the Conference, on behalf of Europe. Currently, the representative of Romania holds the position of vice-chair of the Telecommunication Standardization Advisory Group (TSAG). At the level of the Council Working Groups, Romania's expert also served a second term as vice-chair of the Expert Group on Decision 482.



## Host country of PP-22

In 2022, Romania hosted the Plenipotentiary Conference (PP-22) in Bucharest – the largest ICT event ever held in our country and the most important UN conference organized in Romania since its accession to the United Nations in 1955. PP-22 was widely recognized as one of the most successful ITU Plenipotentiary Conferences in recent history, both in terms of organization and outcomes. Romania was proud to serve as President of the Conference and as European leadership and to facilitate constructive dialogue among all delegates.

# Chair of ITU Council

During the 2024 Council Session, Romania's representative was appointed vice-chair by acclamation. At the 2025 ITU Council Session, ANCOM's delegate was elected as Chair for the 2025 – 2026 term.

Chairing the ITU Council demonstrates our ability to lead with vision and consensus. Under Romania's leadership, the Council has prioritized strategic alignment with ITU goals, streamlined decision-making processes, and enhanced cooperation among member states to address global ICT challenges.
